



## MHLI Training FAQ

**HOW CAN I PAY FOR TRAINING?** Depending on the class, MHLI accepts many different forms of payment. If a class is open to everyone, MHLI accepts checks, credit cards, SF 182s and may also accept central funding from individual services.

**CAN I RECEIVE CONTINUING EDUCATION UNITS?** MHLI is certified by the International Association for Continuing Education & Training (IACET) to offer Continuing Education Units (CEU) for our training. Each course is worth a certain number of CEUs. Please contact us to receive your official CEU transcript.

**ARE THERE ANY CERTIFICATIONS I CAN EARN WITH MHLI TRAINING?** All MHLI classes can be counted towards the Professional Housing Management Association's certification program. Also, the CDPM® and CDUHM courses are certification courses. Visit [www.phma.com/certification](http://www.phma.com/certification) for more information on industry recognized certifications.

**WHAT IS THE DRESS CODE FOR MHLI TRAINING?** Dress code for class is business casual, which does NOT include jeans, shorts or tee shirts. Military dress, if required, is by individual Service.

**WHAT ARE THE CLASS HOURS?** Generally, classes run from 0800 to 1600 with an hour lunch break. Each instructor may run their classes differently and will provide more information the first day of class.

**HOW CAN I FIND OUT LOGISTICAL AND LODGING INFORMATION?** Once you register for a class, MHLI will email you all of the logistical and lodging information for each class. **WHERE ARE CLASSES GIVEN?** MHLI classes are offered around the world. MHLI works very closely with all Services to insure that classes are offered where they are needed. MHLI most often holds classes on military installations, but may also offer classes at different meeting facilities when necessary.
